Levels of National Vocational Qualifications provide recognition of knowledge and experience within the workforce. We provide an On-Site Assessment and Training (OSAT) and Experienced Worker Practical Assessment (EWPA) routes to qualifications for varied levels and skills relevant to the industry.



CSCS Card

The landscape for the Construction Skills Certification Scheme has changed dramatically. All card holders require a qualification relevant to the work that is undertaken on a construction site. No card no access. We guide the industry on the requirements and the route to achievement.



Apprenticeships

What would the future be for the next generation with a route into the Industry. The MPBA are developing a specific apprenticeship scheme for a Modular and Portable Building Operative that will provide an entry point to a career in a growing industry.
